# Important Note on UNHQ Access for NGOs



From paragraph 94 of General Assembly Document <u>A/INF/76/4</u> titled "Access to representatives of non-governmental organizations":

"Owing to the prevailing conditions under COVID-19 and the restricted nature of the arrangements for the seventy-sixth session, access to the United Nations Headquarters premises will not be allowed for representatives of non-governmental organizations in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council or those organizations associated with the Department of Global Communications or of other organizations that do not fall under either category. Special passes for non-governmental organizations either in consultative status with the Economic and Social Council or associated with the Department of Global Communications will therefore not be distributed either by the Non-Governmental Organizations Branch of the Office of Intergovernmental Support and Coordination for Sustainable Development of the Department of Economic and Social Affairs or by the Civil Society Unit of the Outreach Division of the Department of Global Communications. In addition, temporary passes will not be issued."
