
- #Women defending the land & environment fight peacefully in the frontline against #ClimateChange, the preservation of ecosystems & the protection of #HumanRights. They are facing violent campaigns that aim to silence their voices. We stand with women #EnvironmentalDefenders
- Women, especially indigenous & women in the global south, are leading frontline #ClimateAction & activism, but are underrepresented in environmental decision-making at all levels. We must ensure the right of #women to participate in all spaces where decisions are made! #CSW66
- OUN\_Women estimates 64% of #women globally do not have equal land rights to men. We call on Member States at #CSW66 to establish legislation to ban gender-based restrictions on land rights, inheritance rights, & access to financial services.
