Here is a more detailed description of some of the interventions:

a. **Lessons from the Syndemic:** This input is presented alongside contributions on the Global Pact for Education, an Economy with Soul, and the COVID-19 Pandemic. It would be part of the "Judge" component of the "See-Judge-Act" progression in the workshop. The issues will be considered in the spirit of synodal dialogue and discernment, which have been proposed by Pope Francis. The content would have to revolve around: the Pandemic as a global phenomenon (Syndemic); opportunities presented by the pandemic; the lessons of this phenomenon in relation to justice and the fate of the poor. Guillermo Campuzano, CM, typically serves as the speaker on this topic.

b. **Dynamics of JCoR:** This input is part of the "Act" component of the "See-Judge-Act" progression in the workshop. It frames the workshop and ongoing connection with JCoR as a route to the integration of action for justice and peace with participants' existing dynamics of life and mission, communion, and the process proposed by Pope Francis to build a more outward-facing and synodal Church. The content is inspired by the Final Message of the Continental Virtual Workshop of the JCoR in February 2022, specifically around the basic principles of:

1) Reformation of the Church and contribution to social transformation through social justice and environmental justice;

2) Relationship between Synodality, social transformation, equity, and diversity;

3) Relationships between social transformation and politics, between locality and globality, between solidarity and fraternity;

4) Congregational charisms and the Kingdom of God;

5) Mystical and prophetic commitment of Religious Life.

c. **Dreams of Pope Francis**: This input is part of the "Act" component of the "See-Judge-Act" progression in the workshop. It emphasizes *being* more than *doing* by making a commitment to justice in the follow-up action from the workshop. It is based on the themes of Pope Francis' book of this title (November 2020): a poor Church for the poor; going and facing outward; caring for the Common Home; social, cultural, ecological, and ecclesial reconciliation with the Amazon; and holiness in today's world.
