These frameworks compel us to uphold human dignity, prioritise the poorest and most marginalized, care for Earth and her ecosystems, and serve the common good. They detail our mission of service to people and the planet and require our de jure and de facto independence from both governmental entities and corporate interests. We implement these frameworks through a variety of ministries at the community level and through partnership with our peers in civil society. We engage in regular meetings which monitor our adherence to these frameworks. [We also maintain accreditation with the UN [Economic and Social Council/Department of Global Communications] as a non-governmental organization, which we obtained through demonstration of our independent contribution to vision of the human rights framework and UN Charter.]”


