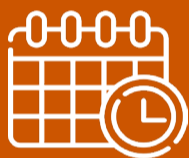

In 2016, Indonesia adopted **National Strategic Projects** (NSP) to develop physical and non-physical infrastructure to increase economic growth. Across West Papua, there are at least ten such projects. However, in the region human rights abuses are closely linked to the **presence of security forces** protecting extractive projects. Reports indicate that military and police have been involved in **extrajudicial killings, torture, and enforced disappearances**. This event will examine specific human rights violations related to NSPs and explore strategies to protect Indigenous Peoples in West Papua.
